HOUSE EXECUTIVE MESSAGE NO. 26

Honorable Speaker Martinez and Members of the House:

I have decided to veto HOUSE BILL 433, as amended, because it is an unnecessary piece of legislation. I have already directed the Higher Education Department to review the availability of Career and Technical Education ("CTE") courses, as well as the compensation for CTE instructors.

Because of these issues, and pursuant to my authority under Article IV, Section 22 of the New Mexico Constitution, I have vetoed HOUSE BILL 433, as amended, enacted by the Fifty-Seventh Legislature, First Session, 2025.
